# let's make cupcake flags!

These little cupcake flags are simple but they can make homemade cupcakes even nicer! They are perfect for a child's birthday, shower, picnics, or any other occasion. I used these flags for mini-cupcakes, but if you wish you can scale them to any size. You can also use a flag as a template to cut and make flags from other papers, such as recycled wrapping paper, wallpaper, magazines, or security envelopes.

#### Supplies:

good-quality paper or cardstock toothpicks or mini-dowels

## Tools:

desktop printer sharp new exacto knife cutting mat ruler glue stick



Print. Cut out flags. Lightly fold, matching the triangle points together.
Glue the entire back side of each flag, and wrap around a toothpick, pressing to set. Done!
